

## Announcement - Communities Around Renewable Energy Projects:

### *Toolkit for Turbines Workshop – findings and feedback*

The COAREP team are pleased to announce their upcoming end-of-project workshop taking place on **December 8<sup>th</sup> 2016** at Western University. Two main goals of the **half-day workshop** are to: 1) present **findings** from recent studies, particularly Walker’s PhD dissertation research (the “toolkit”) which examines wind energy policy programs and social responses to turbine development in Ontario and Nova Scotia; and 2) obtain **feedback** from stakeholders about these findings in the form of roundtable discussions. Feedback will be incorporated into the final version of the toolkit posted on the [coarep.uwo](http://coarep.uwo).

Participants will include a mix of residents living near turbines, academics, policy actors, and developers. Some will attend the workshop in person while the remainder can participate online through GoToWebinar with live video streaming and interactivity.
